

International confce on computer, IT begins in Dhaka

THE three-day-long international conference on computer and information technology began in Dhaka on Friday.

The Department of Computer Science and Engineering at United International University is hosting the 21st conference on the campus.

University Grants Commission chairman Abdul Mannan, UIU board of trustees chairman Hasan Mahmood Raja, UIU vice-chancellor Chowdhury Mofizur Rahman, pro-VC Hasnan Ahmed and teachers Mohammad S Alam and Celia Shahnaz attended the inaugural session.

Eighty-eight papers would be presented during at conference divided in 12 technical sessions, organisers said.

Discussions at the sessions will focus on machine intelligence, network systems and security, signal and image processing, data mining and machine learning, and natural language processing, said the press release.
